	reduce greatly. She further reported that an

## End of Year Forecast 2020/2021

- 6.3. As of 31 Dec 20, Dir Fin reported the Yearend forecast identified an adverse variance of £25,869 but this was expected as this reflected ring-fenced funds being drawn from previous years (roll-over of Board schemes).
- 6.4. Dir Fin presented the proposed Budget for FY2021/2022 line-by-line, highlighting that implementation of the Strategic Review would increase the SDBC Admin charge by 29% but would be offset by reductions in direct Board costs..
- 6.5. The proposed Budget had resulted in a proposed increase in the Penny Rate of 1.36%.
- 6.6. Reserves at 01 Apr 20 were reported as:
  - Ring-fenced (roll-over): £367,000
  - Free-Reserve: £188,000

Predicted reserves at yr-end were reported as:

- Ring-fenced (roll-over): £238,000
- Free Reserve: £282,000

The Clerk reported that critical asset failure was the largest risk to the Board needing to be covered by the Free-Reserves and Insurance.

6.7. Mr P Burden proposed, seconded by Cllr J Tonkin 'that recommendation for the Penny Rate for the year 2021/2022 be increased by 1.36% to 8.996p to be taken to the Board Meeting of 02 Feb 2021 for endorsement.'

	Routine maintenance was 98% complete.	
	<ul> <li>Aspiration to complete all contracts in good time and within ecological constraints, cognisant of Environmental Land Management Schemes (ELMS) and planting timetables.</li> </ul>	
	7.2. Mr G Oliver (The Engineer) reported that South Area works would be going to tender shortly, with an estimated value of £26,000.	
	7.3. The Cut: Concern was expressed that NSC had not undertaken necessary works to clear access to enable routine maintenance work by the Board's maintenance Contractor. The Engineer would investigate further with Mr D Crossman and report at the Full Board on 02 Feb 21.	
	7.4. Mr B Garner enquired whether future development should be an Agenda item to identify developers in-default of their maintenance obligations. Dir Ops replied that this matter should be discussed at full Board, and that currently Officers monitor and react, as necessary, with Board Members assistance.	
8. Risk Review	8.1. The Clerk reported that the full Risk Register would be reported at the Full Meeting of 02 Feb 21, however the Register would be updated for 01 Apr 21 to show significant changes following implementation of the Strategic Review.
