4. Approval of Minutes	 4.1. The Minutes of the Finance & Works Sub-Committee Meeting of 14 June 2022 were accepted as a correct record but as the meeting was not quorate they would have to be taken to the Full Board meeting on 31 January to be signed. 4.2. Cllr Stuart Kingham asked about phosphates but IDS said there was no update and it seems to be very complicated. Tony Bradford said the phosphates will be higher after the recent floods and will be an ongoing problem.

6. Finance Report	6.1.MH ran through the budgets advising that bank reconciliations were up to date and the position as of 31 December 2022 was an underspend of £379k with an estimated year end overspend of £7k. She advised the underspend was due to lack of staff and therefore no money could be spent on Board schemes.	
	6.2. MH discussed the proposed budget for 2023/24, informing Members a couple of the bigger increases include the admin budget which was underfunded last year due to the cost of living increase being higher than budgeted for and this has left an additional staffing cost of £28k on the Boards admin charge. MH then told Members the contracts for routine maintenance allow for CPI in years 2 and 3 and MH has allowed for a 10% increase. Cllr Stuart Kingham queried why there was no budget for court fees or bailiff fees and MH responded by saying no one has been taken to court yet and there is a backlog at the courts so they are prioritising cases and drainage rates would not be a priority.	
	 6.3. Tony Bradford enquired what the Board can do about outstanding rates. He suggested sending a letter to all ratepayers with outstanding rates. Cllr A Betty asked whether interest can be added if a ratepayer doesn't pay within a set time. There was some discussion over the penalty for not paying rates. MH would investigate whether interest can be added to rates by checking the Land Drainage Act. 6.4. MH will write to outstanding ratepayers and advise them to pay within 28 days.
